## Online risks quiz

**1) When you create an account to play a game on a mobile or computer, what information should you not add?**

- Your real name
- Your school
- Your address
- Your parents'/carers' name

**2) You're playing a game and someone you don't know invites you to join their team. What do you do?**

- Accept their invite and play!
- Join the team but don't give out any personal information
- Tell a trusted adult and report them through the game site

**3) You want to play a new game, but you think it might be age restricted. What should you do?**

- Play it at your friends so you can try it before buying
- Ask an older sibling to get it for you
- Check the game website and app for age restrictions

**4) Your cousin has started a new school and you want to check it out. You search for the name of the school but you're not sure which website is the right one. What do you do?**

- Get your cousin to send you the link to their school website
- Ask a trusted adult to help you search
- Click on the link to see if the website looks ok. You can always close the website really quickly if it looks wrong.

**5) You read an article online that says the moon is made of cheese. You don't think this is true. What should you do?**

- Report the site immediately
- Read more about the moon on trustworthy sites
- Share with your friends to see if they think it's true
- Ask a trusted adult to check it out and see if the company who wrote the article is trustworthy

**6) You're watching a video online, and a pop-up appears saying 'Click here to see the cutest puppy on earth'. What do you do?**

- Click it, you want to see the puppy!
- Close the pop-up
- Tell a trusted adult

**7) You get an email from your school saying that your account and password has been hacked. You need to click the link to change your password. What do you do?**

- Click the link and change the password, school wouldn't lie
- Check the email address to see if it's the official school email
- Check with the school to see if it's true
- Log in to my school account and see if the same message is there

**8) Your friend sends you a link to a 'funny' website. When you click on it, you see some pictures which you don't think are funny, but make you feel uncomfortable. What do you do?**

- Tell a trusted adult or talk to Childline
- Tell your friend you don't think it's funny, and you don't think they should be looking at that website
- Don't say anything, but you won't click on anything that friend sends again
