A: Tom has been chatting to someone online in his football game. The person has asked Tom to send a picture of himself in his local football team kit.

B: Tom has been really worried about getting into the school play. He feels like he is rubbish and will be booed off stage.

C: Yasmine has received a text from someone she doesn't know saying that they have information about her that will get her in big trouble. Yasmine should send money otherwise they will tell the police.

D: Tom is in a group chat with his friends at school. They've started being really mean about another boy in his class and he's unhappy about it.

E: Yasmine's babysitter has contacted her online and offered to take her to a theme park next time they look after her. They have asked Yasmine to not tell her parents.

F: Yasmine has been hearing her mum and dad having arguments after she goes to bed. She's worried they might be separating.

G: Tom has been sent a message by his friend online with an attachment. It says the attachment is a "really naughty picture of a lady".



H: Yasmine was doing research for a school project and accidentally visited a website that had pictures of naked men and women on it. It made her feel uncomfortable. Yasmine spoke to her mum who told her not to worry about it but Yasmine is still worried.

I: Tom wants to play online games with his brother but his brother says the games are probably not appropriate for Tom. This has made Tom feel angry.

J: Yasmine's friend has sent her a picture of their friend eating a piece of cake and commented 'piggy'. This has made Yasmine feel uncomfortable.
